Plant Growth Regulators and Cu-based Fungicides

When using plant growth regulators (PGRs), such as B-Nine, be cautious when applying copper-based fungicides (e.g. Phyton, Kocide, Camelot). Some plants, where B-Nine has been applied, may show signs of irregular growth and phytotoxicity.

Using CEASE™ on plants treated with B-Nine offers NO phytotoxicity concerns common with coppers. The liquid formulation of CEASE enables it to go into suspension easily. The use of a spreader/sticker or wetting agent is strongly recommended to improve canopy penetration and coverage.

Therefore, when using PGRs, consider using CEASE for diseases you might typically use coppers to control, and avoid phytotoxicity.
